The uncertified results of the 11/8/11 Non-Homestead Millage Renewal Election are now in! We are extremely pleased to report the following results:

Yes: 4545 votes (76%)

No: 1460 votes (24%)

The Northville Board of Education, district leadership team, teachers and staff gratefully acknowledge the support of the Northville School Community in this effort to maintain the community's investment in our schools.

While approval of the non-homestead millage won't solve the district's current budget crisis, it ensures that the district receives the full operational dollars currently authorized by the state under Proposal A.

Additionally, Northville Public Schools welcomes **Anita Bartschat** and **Scott Craig** to the Northville Public Schools Board of Education in January, 2012. Ms. Bartschat and Mr. Craig were running unopposed for two open, four-year terms on the Board of Education.
