Amerman is the site of the school district's magnet gifted education program for students in third through fifth grade called ALPS (Alternative Learning Programs for Students). Students are assigned to Amerman if they are residents in the Amerman attendance boundary, have made application through the District's open enrollment process, or are enrolled in the 3rd through 5th grade ALPS program. Northville Public Schools has an open enrollment process available for district residents who would like to attend a school within the District that is not in their attendance area. For 2010-2011 and for the past three years, Amerman made Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) in English language arts and mathematics. While we are pleased to have reached this important goal, we are continuously working to improve. We appreciate the continued support of parents, staff and our community in this effort and invite interested parents to become a member of our school improvement team.

We are in the second year of our school improvement plan. Copies of this plan are available at our web site or from the office. We are continuing to experiment with new programs, methods, and intervention techniques to reach our goal of 100% proficiency for all students.

Our curriculum is aligned with the Michigan Department of Education Grade Level Content Standards. Each subject area committee analyzes our curriculum to make sure that it is aligned with state grade level expectations.
